



## Bunker benefit

Caswell Dunes hosted a fundraiser party on Saturday to benefit the 1918 rifle training bunker that has suffered from nine decades of benign neglect. It is a rare remaining example of a range used to teach marksmanship, and volunteers want to stabilize and preserve the structure that was once part of Fort Caswell.
